


Australia oat product exports off to a very strong start for 2022, up 25.8% YOY

- Australia oat product exports are up 25.8% or 3,235 Mt YOY to start the 2021 year. Strong demand for oat foods/Beverages continues to drive the large YOY increases as consumers increasingly look for healthier foods such as oats. Exports have been growing at an astounding annual rate of 12.1% (see below, pg. 3 and attached).
- Combined exports to the five top importers report YOY growth of 29.2 but exports to the top two China and Taiwan are down 12.7% and 18.6% respectively. We expect higher exports to the two as we move forward. Malaysia, India and Japan are all posting a good start to 2022. Exports to the top five combined have been growing at a five-year rage of 15.3%.
- Exports to the other ten major destinations are mainly higher with the Philippines, Thailand and Vietnam posting good five-year growth with Indonesia posting negative growth.
- Western Australia continues to dominate the export market, accounting for 82.6% of total oat product exports by state, up from 79.6% last year. Victoria accounted for 12.5%, down from 14.2% the prior year. Western Australia posted a five-year growth of 16.3% with Victoria at 3.5%. South Australia market share is 4.7%, down from 5.9% the prior year. All other states are reporting negative five-year growth.
- Flake exports continue to dominate the Australian market, accounting for 74.7% with worked oats at 22.3%. Worked oat exports, however, are showing "very strong" growth with a five-year CAGR of 22.8% versus flakes at 9%. This a trend we continue, similar to what we are seeing in other major oat processing markets.
